### Appointments and Scheduling

We offer same day appointments for existing patients, evening appointments and the added convenience of online (virtual) appointments. Appointments for routine physicals should be made well in advance. To schedule, call our office at (616) 355-3801, or you can message us through your patient portal account. Please make every effort to keep your appointment. Should you need to reschedule, please call us at least 24 hours in advance.

### Insurance and Billing

We participate with most insurances. If you have questions about your health plan or coverage, contact your insurance carrier prior to your appointment. If your insurer requires you to have a primary care physician, be sure your Primary Care – Grand Haven provider is listed as your PCP. We will bill your insurance directly, however payment for any copays, deductibles and non-covered services is required at the time of service.
