





School Mental Health Care Manager, Lisa Gort, was nominated by Holland Public Schools Superintendent, Nick Cassidy, for the School Nurse of the Year by the 2024 Michigan Association of School Nurses.

"School Nurse Gort has always been an exceptional provider of health services, but her advocacy for our students and families has transformed how we support families who are experiencing a mental health crisis. By the 2019/20 school year,

Holland Public Schools partnered with Holland Hospital to create the position of School Mental Health Care Manager, with Nurse Gort filling that role. During the last 4 years, Nurse Gort has assured the appropriate use of resources while focusing on positive outcomes, taking a proactive role through the early intervention and identification of at-risk students by performing suicide risk

assessments, as well
