



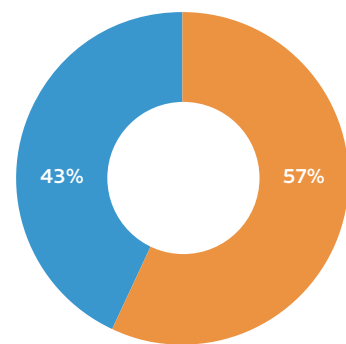

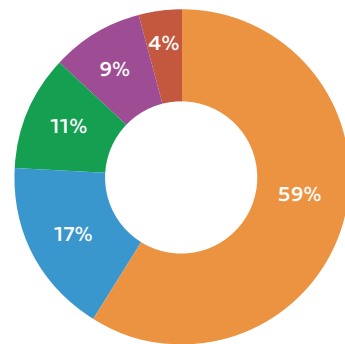

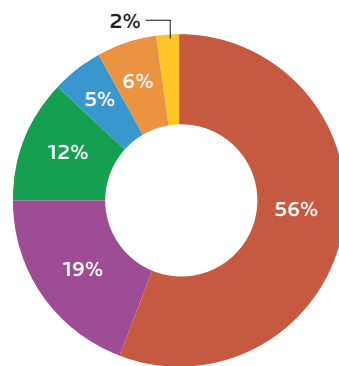

Thank you to Holland Junior Welfare League (HJWL) for their **\$1,215 grant** to purchase AeroChambers for our School Nurse Program. When asthma patients have trouble using Metered Dose Inhalers (MDI), the medication that the MDIs dispense may end up on the back of the throat or on the roof of the mouth rather than in the lungs. AeroChambers help patients inhale MDI medications correctly with minimal waste. The HJWL has donated **over \$14,500 to our Community Outreach Programs since 2010.**

Lisa Gort Named School Nurse of the Year

School Mental Health Care Manager, Lisa Gort, was nominated by Holland Public Schools Superintendent, Nick Cassidy, for the School Nurse of the Year by the 2024 Michigan Association of School Nurses.

"School Nurse Gort has always been an exceptional provider of health services, but her advocacy for our students and families has transformed how we support families who are experiencing a mental health crisis. By the 2019/20 school year, Holland Public Schools partnered with Holland Hospital to create the position of School Mental Health Care Manager, with Nurse Gort filling that role. During the last 4 years, Nurse Gort has assured the appropriate use of resources while focusing on positive outcomes, taking a proactive role through the early intervention and identification of at-risk students by performing suicide risk assessments, as well as partnering with school nurses, school staff, physicians and outside agencies. She has walked alongside students, and their families, as they have navigated our healthcare system during extremely stressful times." – Superintendent Cassidy
